When someone passes away, it's hard to remember everyone who needs to be told. This list can help you take care of these important tasks.

 Pre-paid funeral provider - Funeral Insurance/ Funeral Bond

If the deceased had a pre-paid funeral plan, insurance or bond

Landlord or Real Estate Agent

If the deceased was a tenant, inform the landlord or the real estate agent that manages the property or if the deceased was a landlord, contact the real estate agent who managed the property and collected the rent

Employer/former employer
 If the deceased was employed at the time of their death
