ISLHD COVID-19 update

Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District (ISLHD) is continuing to urge the community to get vaccinated and come forward for testing, after recording 12 positive COVID-19 cases in the 24 hours to 8pm last night.

Given the number of cases reported in the 2527 and 2530 postcodes in the past week, residents of those areas in particular are asked to be extra vigilant, and to come forward for testing if they are experiencing even the mildest of symptoms.

Of the 12 new cases:

- 7 are from the Wollongong Local Government Area (LGA) - 4 are linked to known cases
Postcodes – 2502 (1), 2518 (4), 2526 (2)
- 4 are from the Shoalhaven LGA – 3 are linked to a known case
Postcodes – 2540 (3), 2541 (1)
- 1 is from the Kiama LGA and investigations are ongoing
Postcode – 2534
- 0 are from the Shellharbour LGA

There have now been 2,338 local cases of COVID-19 in the Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District since the start of the current outbreak in June.

As at 8pm Thursday 21 October, there were 23 COVID-19 patients being treated in hospital.

The community is reminded to remain vigilant for symptoms and get tested if any appear, no matter how mild. Symptoms include cold or flu-like symptoms such as fever, sore throat, cough or shortness of breath. People with mild symptoms, such as fatigue, new muscle aches or pains, a change in taste or smell or a new runny nose, should also arrange testing as quickly as possible.

High rates of testing are critical to detecting transmission and preventing further spread of COVID-19 in the community.
