Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District COVID-19 update

ISLHD case numbers

For the 24 hour period to 8pm last night, there were 2169 new COVID-19 cases detected by PCR testing for the Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District. Details are as follows:

- 1152 cases from Wollongong Local Government Area (LGA)
- 467 cases from Shellharbour LGA
- 419 cases from Shoalhaven LGA
- 131 cases from Kiama LGA

As increasingly people follow NSW Health's advice to use rapid antigen tests for diagnosing COVID-19, the number of PCR tests will underestimate the true number of people who have tested positive for COVID-19.

Sadly NSW Health is today reporting the deaths of two people with COVID-19 from our Local Health District: a male in his 70s from the Wollongong Local Government Area (LGA) who was vaccinated and a female in her 60s from the Wollongong LGA who was unvaccinated.

There have been 19,209 community acquired COVID-19 cases reported since 16 June 2021 (cases not necessarily acquired within the Local Health District).

As at 8pm, 11 January there were 93 patients in hospital in the District as a result of COVID (please note, this total may include patients who are no longer COVID-19 positive).
