ISLHD case numbers

There were 912 positive COVID-19 test results (cases) notified for the 24 hour period to 8pm last night – including 507 positive PCR tests and 405 positive rapid antigen tests (RATs).

Please note there may be some cases included in these numbers where people have reported positive RATs on multiple days and/or where people have also had a positive PCR test during the same reporting period.

A breakdown of cases is provided below, please note this breakdown now includes positive PCR tests and RAT results:

- 486 cases from Wollongong Local Government Area (LGA)
- 210 cases from Shellharbour LGA
- 170 cases from Shoalhaven LGA
- 46 cases from Kiama LGA

As at 8pm, 26 January there were 178 COVID-19 cases in hospital in the District (please note, this total may include patients who are no longer COVID-19 positive).

Postcode breakdown

Below we have provided postcodes for confirmed cases reported today as a guide to alert the community who live in these areas that COVID-19 may be circulating in their suburb and surrounds. We do this to ensure all residents within the postcode know they need to be extra vigilant when leaving their home, when monitoring for symptoms and getting tested if they feel unwell. Individual suburb breakdowns are not provided as it does not accurately reflect where cases may have been during their infectious period.
