ISLHD case numbers

There were 556 positive COVID-19 test results (cases) notified for the 24 hour period to 4pm yesterday – including 218 positive PCR tests and 338 positive rapid antigen tests (RATs).

A breakdown of cases is provided below:

- 317 cases from Wollongong Local Government Area (LGA)
- 119 cases from Shellharbour LGA
- 110 cases from Shoalhaven LGA
- 10 cases from Kiama LGA

Sadly, NSW Health is today reporting the death of one person with COVID-19 from our Local Health District. Details are as follows:

• A male in his 80s from Shellharbour LGA who was vaccinated against COVID-19

Moderna vaccine

To create more opportunities for people who wish to receive a vaccine other than Pfizer, the Shellharbour Vaccination Clinic is holding two dedicated days for Moderna booster doses over the next fortnight.

The Shellharbour Clinic will be offering booster doses of the Moderna vaccine to people aged 16 and over next Wednesday, 2 March and the following Wednesday, 9 March.

Please note, Pfizer will not be available at the clinic on these days.

People are encouraged to walk-in, or book an appointment by calling the Illawarra and Shoalhaven Vaccination Booking Team on 1300 096 365 during business hours, or online via the Vaccine Clinic Finder or the COVID-19 Vaccination Support form.

Booster doses of the Moderna vaccine are also available at the Mass Vaccination Centre in Wollongong.
