Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District COVID-19 update

ISLHD case numbers

There were 505 positive COVID-19 test results (cases) notified for the 24 hour period to 4pm yesterday – including 210 positive PCR tests and 295 positive rapid antigen tests (RATs).

A breakdown of cases is provided below:

- 297 cases from Wollongong Local Government Area (LGA)
- 108 cases from Shellharbour LGA
- 81 cases from Shoalhaven LGA
- 19 cases from Kiama LGA

The community is reminded that while the requirement for masks in most settings has been lifted from today, masks are still required in hospitals, aged and disability care facilities and corrections facilities, as well as on public transport, planes, indoors at airports, and indoor music festivals with more than 1,000 people.

Further, we advise that while NSW Health yesterday announced that public health services across the state would move to Amber Alert Level effective immediately, there is currently no change to visitor numbers and visitor entry requirements.
