Acute Myocardial Infarct	ARTEMIS: Ziltivekimab (anti-inflammatory monoclonal antibody) versus placebo on patients with acute myocardial infarct CV outcome study. Monthly injections	A/Prof Lee	
Acute Coronary Syndrome RECRUITMENT CURRENTLY ON HOLD	LIBREXIA: Milvexian (Factor Xia inhibitor) versus placebo in patients after a recent acute coronary syndrome. Investigating the efficacy and safety. Oral tablet taken twice a day.	A/Prof Lee	
Acute Myocardial Infarct	SOS-AMI: Self-administered selatogrel (or placebo) injection for prevention and treatment of acute myocardial infarction in participants with a recent history of acute myocardial infarction. Self administered injection only if and when required.	A/Prof Lee	
Pulmonary Hypertension	APEX: TX000045 (a relaxin-like compound) versus placebo in patients with pulmonary hypertension secondary to heart failure. Investigating safety and effectiveness of TX000045. Injections every 2 weeks.	Dr Moragues
