



Conversations in Clinical Supervision

The ISHEC is a Health Education and Training Institute (HETI) approved Centre with accredited Faculty to conduct this course across the ISLHD.

Conversations in Clinical Supervision is an interdisciplinary course delivered over one day which focuses on communication skills relevant to interviewing students.

The course aims to develop interview techniques relevant to a range of clinical supervision activities for students/staff including:

- establishing a supervisory relationship and providing effective orientation
- goal setting and guiding students to learn effectively within the clinical learning environment
- formative assessment, giving feedback, supporting and coaching students with difficulties and motivating students to change behaviour, maximise performance or develop resilience
- following up complaints and issues

The training is aimed at staff from professions of Allied Health, Medicine, and Nursing who have a direct role in clinical supervision.
