

What evidence do I need?

dTpa	1 adult dose in last 10 years (vaccine must contain diphtheria, tetanus & pertussis)
Hepatitis B	<p>Childhood schedule of 3 /4 doses given under 20 yrs. of age OR Adolescent schedule of 2 doses - School based Program given from 11-15 yrs. of age OR Adult schedule x 3 doses given over 20 yrs. of age AND Anti-HBs of 10 IU/ml or more</p> <hr/> <p>OR positive Anti-HBc (indicating past Hepatitis infection)</p>
MMR	<p>2 doses at least 4 weeks (28 days) apart OR positive serology for all 3 diseases (Rubella must be shown as a numerical value) OR birthdate before 1966</p>
Varicella	<p>2 doses at least 4 weeks (28 days) apart OR 1 dose if given before age 14 OR 1 dose of Zostavax if given at age over 50 OR positive serology for varicella OR An Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) history statement that records natural Immunity to chickenpox. A verbal statement of previous disease must not be accepted.</p>
TB	Negative IGRA / TST if born in, lived in or visited high-risk TB countries totalling 3 months or more
