Obtaining Evidence of Vaccinations for Health Care Workers and Students

Evidence of Vaccinations

Evidence should be presented on the NSW Health <u>Vaccination</u> <u>Record for Health Care Workers and Students</u> and **must** include the following:

- · Name of vaccine
- Date given
- Batch No. or Brand Name (where possible)
- Official Certification by Vaccination Provider (clinic/practice stamp, full name and signature next to each entry)
- Copies of vaccination records (e.g. childhood vaccinations) and copies of relevant pathology reports may be attached to the card, if available.

Evidence of Serology

Serological results should be recorded on the card as numerical values or positive/negative, as appropriate, not simply "immune"

Where to find records - sources of information

- NSW Health Vaccination Record Card for Health Workers and Students with personal details completed
- For existing NSW Health employees request an immunisation report from local health district (LHD)
- <u>Baby Blue Book</u> (if born in Australia)
- Childhood vaccination records from birth country
- The <u>Australian Immunisation Register</u> for immunisation records after 1996 (Australian residents only)
- · Your family General Practitioner (GP) may be a good source of vaccination records
